

Senior year is here for the Class of 2019 and it will be a busy, fun and exciting time. New this year the Green Senior Folder is completely digital. You no longer need to pick up your folder with the other "Back-to-School" material the week before school starts. Please take some time to review this and make a note of important deadlines. Many events are mandatory and occur early in the year. We highlight some of these in more detail here.

Key Senior Class Dates

September 4th - Senior Class Dinner 6PM and Mandatory College Night 7pm

Senior College Night is hosted by student services and is <u>mandatory</u> for all seniors. Students will learn about their counselor's specific requirements in the college application process, including required documents and critical deadlines. Both students and parents are encouraged to attend, as the School Counselors will be unable to meet with families individually. The program begins at 7PM

Prior to the College Night program, we invite you to join us for our final class dinner in the cafeteria from 6:00 to 7:00 PM. This is an opportunity to reconnect with other Class of 2019 families and hear important information about senior year activities. Please buy tickets by logging in to your MySchoolBucks.com account (the same website used to add money to students' cafeteria account). At the top of the page under the "School Store," select browse all items. Click on the "Class of 2019 Dinner" icon, and add tickets to your cart. The cost of the dinner is \$10 per person. The deadline for ordering tickets on line is Friday August 30th.

September 17th - Senior Dues (MANDATORY) Deadline

Every senior student is required to pay class dues of \$120. Please pay your dues on time to guarantee your Class t-shirt. Dues can be paid through MySchoolBucks.com by navigating to the "School Store," browse all items and select the "Class of 2019 Dues" icon. If you have more than one Langley senior you will need to add each student's dues to your cart separately. Senior dues cover graduation expenses, as well as the cost of the senior field trip, the senior picnic, the senior breakfast, Ethics Day, senior treats, Homecoming Week class t-shirts and more. If payment of dues is a financial hardship, contact Student Services for confidential assistance. Please note that graduation tickets will not be released and students will not be permitted to walk at graduation until class dues and all outstanding financial obligations to Langley High School have been paid.

September 26th—Senior Swag Orders Due

These items were specifically designed for the Class of 2019 by the senior class officers and are only available to our seniors. Show your class spirit by wearing these all year long. Ordering will be online only and items will be delivered to students in the cafeteria during Homecoming Week (October 22-25). Parents wishing to place a message of congratulations may purchase ad space in the Langley 2018-19 yearbook. Senior Ad orders may be submitted beginning on Tuesday August 28th and will continue as long as space is available, or until November 21, 2018, whichever comes first.
